



AFFILIATED CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of this policy is to assist in developing and encouraging a culture of good practices. As an Affiliated Club to the British Sleddog Sports Federation (BSSF), it is agreed that the following Code of Conduct will be adhered to:

- All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the rules, understand and adhere to them. If there are any queries regarding the rules, please speak directly to a Council Member.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- All members should be a positive role model, treat other members/clubs and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.
- Bullying of any sort (physical, emotional or sexual) will not be tolerated. This includes the use of Social Media. Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
- The use of Social Media is encouraged, however comments that: contains vulgar, obscene or indecent language; defames, abuses or threatens others; or are bigoted, hateful or racially offensive, will be deleted and appropriate action will be taken.
- All members will take actions that are consistent with the Core Values of BSSF and its Constitution.
- All members will dedicate their efforts to the spirit of the sport.
- All members maintain any BSSF equipment in good condition for use by other members.
- Clubs will recognise that a breach of this Code may result in disciplinary action with potential sanction.
